- Timex – “Takes a licking. Keeps on ticking.”
- Del Taco – Super Special Show
- Minute Maid – “Put good in. Get good out.”
- Mazda – “Zoom. Zoom”

Among the displays featured are three-dimensional items including a tricked-out Coleman camp site, one of the hand-crafted cardboard models used in the animation for The UPS Store “Cardboard World” online game, and a clay animation figure of the Serta Counting Sheep #8 created for the commercials by Aardman Animations.

“Creative Week,” which has been officially declared by the office of Mayor Bloomberg and the City of New York, is a celebration of creativity in advertising, design, digital media and the arts. The One Club and the Creative Week Board of Advisors have invited all organizations involved in the creative life of New York City—museums, theater and dance companies, advertising and design agencies, bands, filmmakers, etc.—to participate by hosting an event.
